- (a) Since, equipment is an uncountable noun. So, it should not be used in plural form.
- (b) Scissors are always used in plural form. So, use 'are' in place of 'is'.
- (b) According to the sense of sentence 'principals' should be replaced by 'principles'.
- (c) Eye is used as an adjective to definie the noun 'surgery'. So, it will be used in singular form.
- 5. (b) Use 'luggage' in place of 'luggages' as it is an uncountable noun.
- 6. (b) Use 'is' in place of 'are', because 'Gulliver's Travels' is the name of a book.
- 7. (b) Use 'spoonfuls' in place of 'spoonsful'.
- (c) 'Lap' is an uncountable noun. So, it should not be used in plural form.
- 9. (d) No error.
- (a) Since, 'news' is a singular noun. So, it will take a singular verb i.e. 'travels' in place of 'travel'.
- (c) Because sort is used after plural word 'those'. So, it should be in plural form 'sorts'.
- (c) Conclusion is always final. So, final should not be used before it.
- (c) 'Study' should be replaced by 'studies', because 'study' is a verb.
- 14. (c) Plural form of 'formula' is 'formulae'.
- 15. (b) Use 'information' in place of 'informations' as it is an uncountable noun.
- 16. (a) 'Honestly' is an adverb while 'honesty' is a noun. So, 'honesty' should be used in place of 'honestly'.

- 20. (a) 'Rupee' in place of 'rupees' as it is doing the work of an adjective here.

- 22. (b) 'A number of always takes plural noun. So, use 'criteria' in place of 'criterions'.
- 23. (a) Use 'Women' in place of 'woman' as it is referring to the plural in (c) part.
- 24. (d) No error.
- 25. (b) Use 'workman' in place of 'workmen' because with one, plural noun workmen is wrongly used.
- 26. (a) 'Two thirt' should be replaced by 'two thirds' because it is referring to a plural quantity.
- 27. (b) When 'a pair of' is used before a plural noun, verb should be in singular form. So, use 'was' in place of 'were'.
- 28. (a) Here 'boy' is used as an adjective used to define noun 'students'. So, it should be used in singular form.
- 29. (b) Use 'poetry' in place of 'poetries' because it is an uncountable noun.
- (c) Since 'manners' is always plural. So, it should not be used in singular.
- 31. (a) Since 'tooth' is a countable noun and its plural form is 'teeth'. Here counting is given before tooth. So, 'teeth' should be used here.
- 32. (c) 'An urgent work' should be replaced by 'an urgent piece of work',
- (b) 'Police' is a collective noun and always takes plural verb with it. So, replace 'has' with 'have'.
