- 1. (b) 'Although' is followed by 'yet' and not by 'but'.
- 2. (b) 'Else' is followed by 'but'. So, replace 'than' with 'but'.
- (b) 'Hardly' is always followed by 'when'. So, use 'when' in place of 'then'.
- 4. (a) 'Seldom if ever' and 'seldom or never' are correct expressions.
- 5. (b) Use 'and' in place of 'as well as'.
- 6. (b) 'Such that' is used for the consequence of an action. So, use 'that' in place of 'as'.
- (c) Replace 'or' by 'nor' because 'neither' is always followed by 'nor'.
- 8. (c) Use 'as' in place of 'that'.
- 9. (b) Since the reporting verb is asked. So, the subordinate clause should be started with 'whether' or 'if' in place of 'that'.
- 10. (b) 'Other' is followed by 'than' in place of 'but'.
- 11. (c) Use 'as' in place of 'equally' for comparison.
